DID YOU KNOW...



- *MORE AFRICAN AMERICAN WOMEN DIE OF BREAST CANCER THAN CAUCASIAN WOMEN
- *HISPANIC WOMEN MAY HAVE A HIGHER NUMBER OF BARRIERS TO GETTING MOMMOGRAMS THAN WOMEN OF OTHER ETHNICITIES
- *WOMEN WITH A FAMILY HISTORY AND WHO ARE AGE 40+ ARE AT A HIGHER RISK FOR DEVELOPING BREAST CANCER
- *EVERY 2 MINUTES A WOMAN IS DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER AND 1 WOMAN WILL DIE OF BREAST CANCER EVERY 13 MINUTES
- *BREAST CANCER IS THE SECOND LEADING CAUSE OF CANCER DEATH AMONG WOMEN
